

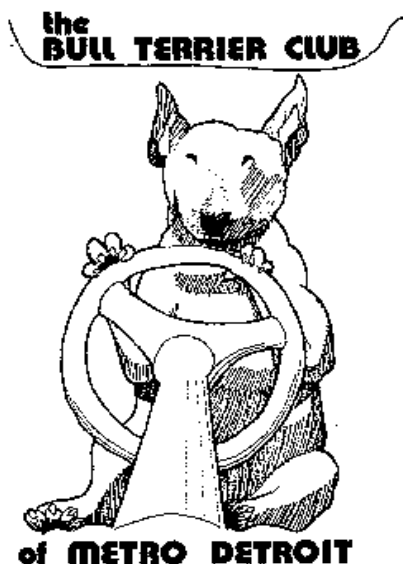

NON REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

VETERAN DOG AND BITCH: For Dogs and Bitches 7 years old and over on the show date. Spayed bitches and neutered dogs are eligible to compete in the Veteran classes at this show.

NON REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two or more of their get. Stud Dog must be entered in the class and shown in the ring with the Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Variety Competition, or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: Same as for Stud Dog, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

AWARDS OF MERIT - After the awarding of Best of Variety, Best Opposite Sex and Best of Winners in each variety, the judge may award up to two (2) Awards of Merit to the remaining dogs and bitches in Best of Variety competition

BEST IN THE PUPPY CLASSES - After the judging of Best of Variety in each variety, the first place winners of the 6-9 and 9-12 month Puppy Dog and Puppy Bitch classes will compete for Best in the Puppy Classes in Variety. After the judging of Best of Breed Competition, the Best in the Puppy Classes in each Variety will compete for Best in the Puppy Classes in Breed.

BEST IN THE VETERANS CLASSES - After the judging of Best of Breed the first place winners of each Veterans class in both varieties will compete for Best in the Veterans Classes in Breed.

BEST MOVING BULL TERRIER - After the judging of Best of Breed, and Best in the Puppy Classes in Breed, Winners and Reserve Winners in both varieties and all Champions of Record entered in Best of Variety Competition may compete for Best Moving Bull Terrier.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW

The show site is located at 700 Careltn-S. Rockwood Rd in Carleton Michigan. This is approximately 30 minutes from Detroit Metropolitan Airport. The site is 20 minutes from the Monroe Country Fairgrounds.

FROM THE SOUTH: Take I-75 North to I-275 North. Take I-275 North to Exit 5, Carleton-S.Rockwood Rd. Turn left over the freeway and the VFW hall will be visible on the left side of the road.

FROM THE NORTH: I-75 South to I-275 North, follow directions above.

FROM CANADA (VIA WINDSOR): Take 401 West to Ambassador Bridge. Once over the bridge, turn left over the freeway, then left again to follow I-75 South and follow directions above.

FROM DETROIT METROPOLITAN AIRPORT: Take I-94 West to I-275. I-275 South to Exit 5, Carleton-S.Rockwood Rd. Turn right, the VFW hall will be on your right.

SHOW REGULATIONS

Show hours are from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM Eastern Daylight Time.
The show site will be accessible at 7:00 AM Saturday, October 1, 2005

An AKC recording fee of 50 cents and an AKC event service fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member club show, obedience trial or tracking test. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2).

ENTRY FEES are \$27.00 for all classes, EXCEPT Puppy, Veterans, Stud Dog and Brood Bitch which are \$18.00 These fees include the 50 cent AKC recording fee and \$3.00 AKC Event fee. Additional entries are \$18.00. Sweepstakes entry fee is \$12.00

PLEASE NOTE THESE AKC RULES. Dogs which are entered in a class in violation of these rules **WILL LOSE ALL AWARDS AND POINTS** from this show.

All dogs entered in the **Bred by Exhibitor** classes must:

- Have an individual registration number with the American Kennel Club.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog
- To exhibit in the this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record

Dogs entered in the **American Bred** classes must have been whelped in the United States by reason of a mating which also took place in the United States. (American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 3, Section 8).

No dog that has not been **individually registered** with The American Kennel Club when first entered in a licensed or member dog show shall be eligible to be entered in any licensed or member dog show that is held more than **30 days** after the date of the first licensed or member dog show in which it was entered, unless the dog's individual AKC registration number is shown on the entry form, or unless the owner has received from The American Kennel Club an extension notice in writing authorizing further entries of the dog for a specified time with its AKC litter number or individual foreign registration number. (American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 11, Section 1.)

Make all checks and money orders payable in U.S. funds to the Bull Terrier Club of Metro Detroit. Please mail checks or money orders with entries.

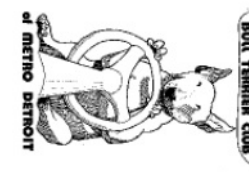
Telephone, telegraph and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of \$10 to the amount of each returned check.

Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE

AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
